CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY SUMMARY

Below is a summary of WCSA fees and regulations regarding a new connection of service.

- The current one-time connection fee for residential connection is \$1,900.00. This may be paid in full or as a \$100.00-monthly payment over a one (1) year period. If payments are to be made, a \$700.00 deposit is required at application for service. The \$100.00 monthly payment will then be included in the regular water bill for 12 months.
- The current minimum monthly bill for water service is \$17.50 and includes up to 1,000 gallons. For each additional 1,000 gallons used, the charge is \$3.10 per 1,000 gallons from 1,001-3,999 gallons and \$3.70 per 1,000 gallons over 4,000 gallons. The typical WCSA customer uses 5,000 gallons of water per month, which would result in a monthly bill of \$31.10.
- The homeowner is responsible for all plumbing on the residence side of the meter. This will include bringing the plumbing to the meter (generally set near the property line) and installing a pressure reducing valve and cutoff valve on the residence side of the meter.
- The meter will be set at or close to the property line that faces the road. If there is a road right-of-way, the meter will be set close to where the right-of-way ends.
- All private sources of water (wells, springs, etc.) must be disconnected from the house plumbing before WCSA service will be provided.
